

2. Committee to verify all relevant documents of vehicles on updation.
3. Devising & enforcing "No Helmet, No Entry" policy in your institution with hoarding to be displayed on entrance gate.
4. Carry out road safety awareness programmes in a scientific and systematic manner.
5. Undertake programmes to educate all stakeholders on roads safety evaluate strategies that have maximum effect.
6. Wide spread awareness on "Good Samaritan" guideline and "Good Samaritan Award" Scheme in a District.
